CF forms establish your project's compliance with energy use requirements.

- CF-1R Forms – Provided along with plan submittal, these document what you intend to install, e.g. 92% carrier furnace, 40-gallon Bradford tank water heater, insulation, etc.
- CF-2R Forms – Provided at the finish of your project, along with other final documents, these document which components were installed in a residential or multi-family dwelling.

You may find further information on energy requirements and download CF forms using the helpful links below. You may need to explore menus within the page to find the forms that apply to your project. Forms are categorized by area of work, e.g. Lighting, Solar, Glazing, etc.
